

Kit Perona-Wright - Artistic Director

Kit Perona-Wright started his musical life at school in Surrey as performer, singer, composer and conductor. From here, he accepted a place at Exeter University to study for a music degree, which he combined with a scholarship at Exeter Cathedral.

During this time, he gained much valuable experience as either conductor or accompanist to many choirs/ensembles in the South West – such as Exeter Cathedral choir, University Singers, Cantors (Early music specialists), Counterpoint chamber choir, various local choral societies and many others.

He formed his own choir – The Serlo Consort - consisting of local professional singers in 2000.

In 2001, Kit left Exeter with a Masters degree in English Cathedral Music and Liturgy, a first class music degree with a Dean's commendation for academic excellence, and diplomas from the Royal College of Organists in both organ playing and choral direction.

He took up a position at the Royal School of Church Music (RSCM) in 2001, working for them in various capacities – such as administrator, composer, arranger, accompanist, conductor, and was involved in a busy schedule of workshops and other events for the RSCM that took him all over the UK and abroad.

From September 2005, Kit joined the music staff at Dulwich College Prep School as both teacher and Head of Keyboard, in addition to devoting more time to an increasingly busy Serlo Consort schedule!

Alongside this, Kit is currently organist at St. John the Evangelist, Upper Norwood, conductor of Carshalton Choral Society, an elected member of the Royal Society of Musicians, and a Fellow of the London College of Music.
